

WOMEN AT THE BSN

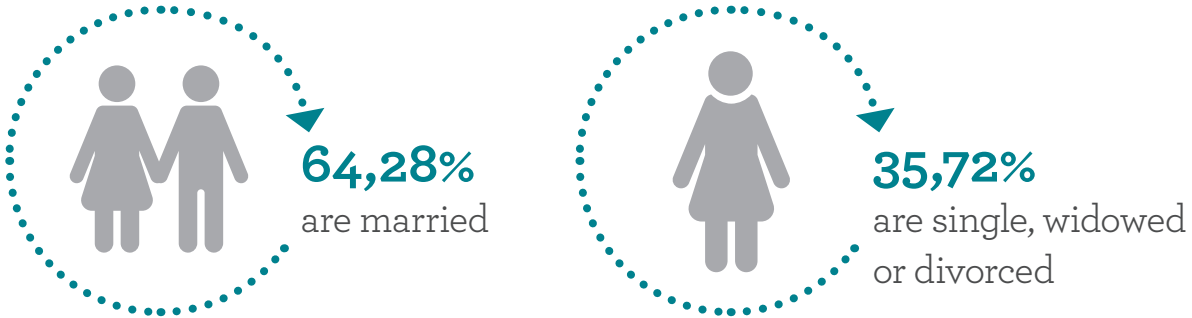

Some of them formed a family earlier, some later.

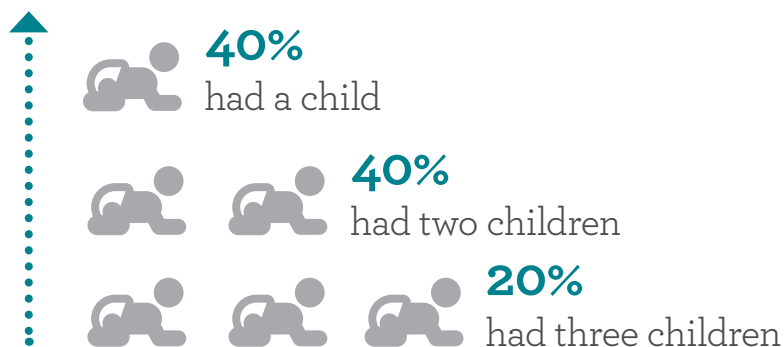


CHILDREN

However, few of them opted for the third child, most are between one or two children.

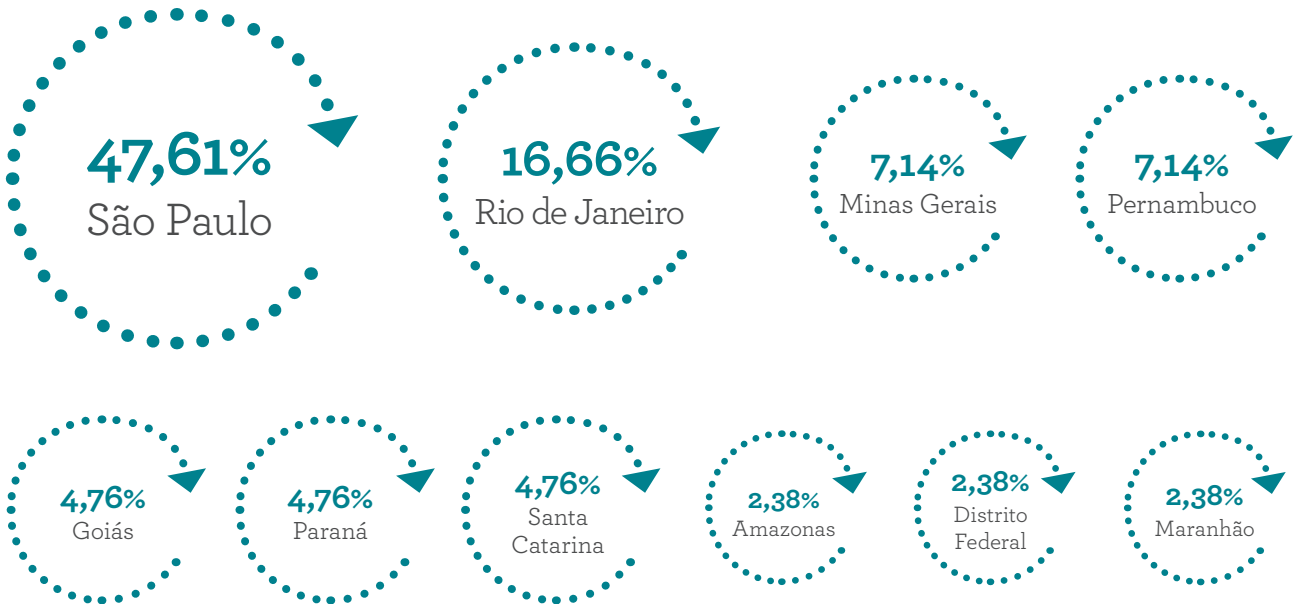


Of respondents who answered yes:



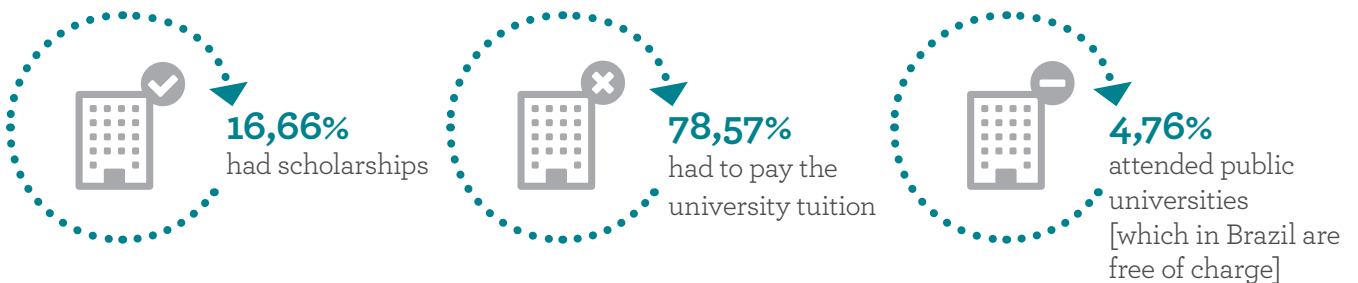
AREA OF WORK

São Paulo is the state that leads the performance of the female neurosurgeons interviewed, but they are present in almost all Brazilian territory.



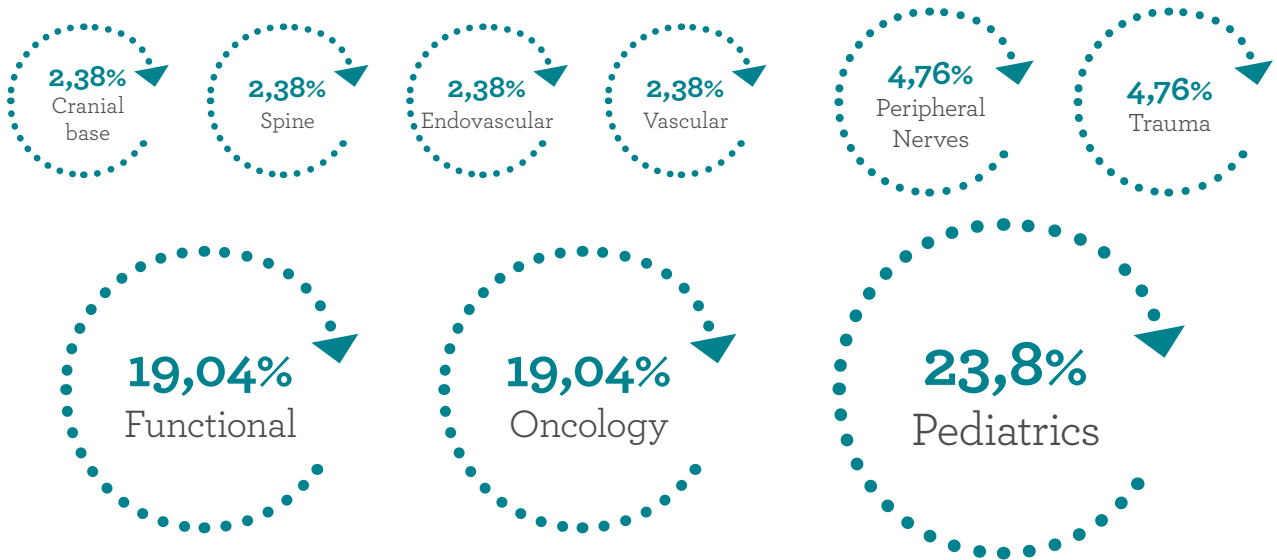
SCHOLARSHIP

With the exception of two interviewees who attended public college, almost all neurosurgeons had to invest in their own education.
